JUNIOR GOLF RULES

PARENTS VOLUNTEERS:

We encourage parents to take part in the Junior Golf and to watch their son or daughter grow with the game of golf. We also need parent volunteers each week during the Thursday Golf League. By having parent volunteers it allows us to focus more on helping improve their golf games on course. My first goal is to make sure every junior golfer is safe from harm and with another set of eyes it allows us to do that and the staff can focus helping your son or daughter on course.

DRESS CODE:

Our junior golfers must follow the Medallion Club dress code policy. Shirts must be tucked in at all times and their hats must be worn forward. No denim, T-shirts, cargo shorts, or gym shorts will be allowed. Boys shirts must have collars.

BEHAVIOR:

If you son or daughter is distracting from the learning of others will we ask them politely to correct their behavior. If they become more of a problem we will inform the parents of the situation.
